Dorene Kaiser, age 81, of Jamestown, MO, passed away on January 18, 2021, at the Moniteau Care Center in California, MO. She was born January 11, 1940, in the rural area of Cole Camp, MO, the daughter of Gerhardt and Irene Kaiser, both of whom preceded her in death.

She was a graduate of Smith-Cotton High School in Sedalia, MO, and as a youth, she was an active member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Sedalia.
